Susan: Another example: In Rebecca's high school, we had teachers who really believed in the importance of Rebecca having friends, and they actually built it into the curriculum where students would create opportunities for Rebecca to do some very inclusive work in school--but also getting involved in outside activities. And the students would get credit for it. So it gave them the opportunity to get to know her a little better, and again, potentially becoming friends. Not all of them did, but at least it was a little introduction to it. So there's different ways of doing it.
